4 Paws for Ability, Inc. - Privacy Policy

4 Paws for Ability, Inc. is a non-profit organization committed to respecting the privacy of our donors, website visitors, volunteers and clients (hereinafter "Supporters" or "Supporter") that we serve. This Privacy Policy applies to any Supporter information provided to 4 Paws for Ability.

Information that we may collect includes:

- Supporter information such as name, organization/company, complete address, phone number, email address, or other information provided to us by Supporters
- Donation information for Supporters who donate including amounts donated, date of donation(s), comments or notes provided with a donation, and preferences related to that donation (i.e., elections to remain anonymous or not be further contacted by us)
- Information from your visits to our website, such as what pages you visit, collected with web beacons, cookies, event tags or similar technologies for us to analyze what and how Supporters use our website
- Information that our vendors provide to us that they've collected based on their pre-existing relationships with our Supporters, such as the last 4 digits of your credit card number on a receipt for a transaction processed by our vendor. 4 Paws for Ability does not collect or retain credit card numbers, other than the last 4 digits, or other credit card details, such as the expiration date or CVV number
- Information about pets of Supporters who serve as volunteers, which may include veterinarian and medical records about those pets
- Information about Supporters who report to us about their experiences with service dogs in-training
- Information that is not identifiable to Supporters

How Information is Used:

- 4 Paws for Ability only collects information that we believe is reasonable and useful for our business purposes.
- Examples of our business purposes that we deem reasonable and useful are using data to:
 - maintain records of donations
 - send newsletters or otherwise communicate with our Supporters but only about 4 Paws for Ability business purposes
 - deliver to donors their year-end tax statements
 - assess Supporters for volunteer or adoption opportunities
 - analyze who visits our website and what they do on our website to improve our website and our ability to reach people interested in the 4 Paws for Ability mission
 - contact you to market our services, about events or donating, though you can contact us to unenroll from receiving these communications
 - to comply with our legal obligations or if we have a good faith belief that such action is necessary to conform to legal requirements or legal process served on us

How Information is Shared:

- 4 Paws for Ability shares Supporter data, including identifiable information, with our service providers, such as our mailing vendor, which are subject to contractual restrictions on how they can use or share such information.
- We may publish a list of those Supporters who are donors or sponsors in our Annual Report or event programs unless you've requested that the donation be kept anonymous.
- We share information about donations and Supporters who donate with the IRS as we are required for IRS Form 990, Schedule B when donations are over \$5,000.
- We will share your information to comply with the law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to conform to the requirements of law or comply with the legal process served on us.
- We may share your identifiable information with your consent for other business purposes.
- We may share de-identified Supporter information with third parties.

Information Access & Security

- 4 Paws for Ability restricts internal access to identifiable information (e.g., Supporter contact information) to individuals with a need-to-know. All individuals accessing identifiable information on behalf of 4 Paws for Ability must first sign a confidentiality agreement.
- Our website has a SSL certificate to help us keep your information safe when you are on our website.

Supporters in Locations with Additional Privacy Rights

- Supporters in certain locations may have certain additional rights like those granted under the California Consumer Privacy Protection Act. This may include rights to request access or to update or review your information, request that it be deleted or anonymized, or object to or restrict us from using it for certain purposes.
